At first I was not sure how ministry would look going forward; then I heard about Zoom and that has been working well. I am pleased to meet and 'see' the gals I have the honor to journey alongside. As well, I use Zoom for leading our Healing Hearts Ladies Bible study and being a part of our Healing Hearts prayer times. Phone calls and sending cards are also ways to connect. Not going out for meetings has freed up time for enjoying more time with the Lord and reading ministry help books.

In my last letter I told you I would update you on the progress of the project at Healing Hearts. March 15 was the last week that we had a service there so the pressure was off to get it down quickly. The last couple of weeks Wally has spent time there after work and on Saturdays trying to get the project completed. The last of the ordered materials are now here so he is hoping to have it finished in the next week or so.

God has been showing me over and over that He is in control, that my safety / protection is in Him and Him alone, that He has plans for me, that I need to have a heart of gratitude and thanksgiving, that I need to love everyone (even my enemies), that I need to keep my eyes on Jesus and not on the circumstances or situations and the list goes on. I have also started audibly using Scripture as prayer and thanksgiving—which makes it personal and has greater meaning to me.

In the midst of crisis and chaos I can still choose to be thankful. I would like to share with you my prayer of thanks to God using Psalm 23 from The Passion Translation:

*Thank you Lord for being my best friend and my shepherd.  
Thank you that I always have more than enough.  
Thank you that you offer a resting place for me in Your luxurious love.
